March 4, 2009

Praise/Prayer

Language: This for me is a great, great, great, uphill battle. I do get some victories! Friday the 13th after two and a half days of studying the Lord's Prayer I could completely say it in Jinghpaw. This was a great victory for me personally.

Food: I think I eat too much over here but the food is really good. (He likes his Ni Ba (chilly powder)...

Last week when Hkaw Win was an away, training deacon, she had the blessing of praying the sinner prayer with about 29 of them. What a harvest! Hkaw Win told me that she felt so blessed inside. It really touched her heart.

This week Hkaw win and I went to another village to celebrate a ten-year nursery school reunion and a graduation. It was an exciting time and the anointing was really there. I was the first outsider to ever come to that body of believers. We had a great time sleeping in an old thatch, bamboo house. The last night we also had two chickens sleeping in the same room with us beside the bed on the floor. They were part of an appreciation gift that was given.

Hkaw Win Nursery school assistant just had a baby boy one month ahead of schedule. Mom and son are doing fine but now we have to fill in some spaces that she was to be involved in for the next few weeks.

Friday Hkaw Win and I will train another 40 or more nursery school leaders and we are praying for more harvest. Then on Saturday we will have a closing service of this 5-week course that Hkaw Win and her team were running.

Then on Sunday we head off to renew my papers again, this time for the one-year extension. We are looking forward for the time away but it will be very busy because we also have to work at getting Hkaw Win passport extended too.

When we get back we will attend the MBA convention. There will be a lot of changes that will take place during this convention. It is Hkaw Win half waypoint to her 4-year term and it is the end of Sam Son being the MBA Secretary. He will move to his new position of Principle of the new MBA Bible School. (Project Lambs 30 Courses will become a major foundation stone to this school ministry).

I should tell you that we have had the booklet on the Lord's Prayer translated and also the booklet that teaches on having a personal relationship with God.

We are excited at the possibility of having some visitors between May and August. Rachel and Andi may be coming to visit us in May. Lord willing we will also see Peter Broesky visiting us. There are many others who have expressed interest in coming to this great country.

March 6,09

This is the big one-year visa renewal. Also we will need to extend Hkaw Win passport. This will require lots of paperwork. Please talk with the father about this. We will be away about 7 to 10 days. Things have been very busy. We are excited to tell you that another 38 College and career age people come into the Kingdom of God yesterday. The harvest on the different farms is continuing. What a great day we had. There is great joy in the camp.

We see more coming on the horizon. We pray that the harvest will grow from a stream, to a river, and then a great flood.
